

## Post Operative Drop Information

### OSRX

- Your prescription for post operative eye drops has been electronically sent to OSRX Pharmaceuticals and should be delivered to you within 5 to 7 days.
  - The ophthalmic drops you will receive are three prescription drops compounded into one bottle. **The compounded medication consists of Prednisolone Phosphate 1% (steroid), Moxifloxacin 0.5% (antibiotic), and Bromfenac 0.075% (non-steroidal anti-inflammatory).**
  - You will receive a phone call from the pharmacy to confirm your shipping address.
  - If you are proceeding with surgery in both eyes, you will receive two bottles, one for each eye.
  - If you are proceeding with surgery in one eye only, you will receive one bottle for the surgical eye.
- Your post op drops will start **after** your surgery of the surgical eye(s) unless otherwise noted by your doctor.
- Specific drop schedules will be given to you on the day of surgery and will be reviewed with you before you leave the office.
- It is recommended that you use Preservative Free Artificial Tears (you may purchase these over the counter, no prescription is required) **as needed** after surgery if you are experiencing any discomfort, irritation, dryness, or foreign body sensation.



## Post Operative Drop Information

- Your prescription for post operative eye drops has been electronically sent to your local pharmacy and should be ready for you to pick up in the next few days.
  - If you requested a hard copy of your prescriptions for these eye drops, please remember to have the prescriptions filled prior to your surgery.
- Your post op drops will start **after** your surgery of the surgical eye(s) unless otherwise noted by your doctor.
- Specific drop schedules will be given to you on the day of surgery and will be reviewed with you before you leave the office.
- It is recommended that you use Preservative Free Artificial Tears (you may purchase these over the counter, no prescription is required) **as needed** after surgery if you are experiencing any discomfort, irritation, dryness, or foreign body sensation.
